Caring Without Pause: Kaohsiung Branch Extends Mid-Autumn Warmth to the Vulnerable Groups

During the enforcement process, staff members of the Kaohsiung Branch identified a debtor, an elderly woman in her seventies surnamed Lee, who holds a disability identification card and is suffering from Alzheimer's disease. She is a registered case with the Cishan Disability Center of the Social Affairs Bureau. Currently bedridden and unable to move independently, she is under the care of her elderly husband, as their children are either incarcerated or unaccounted for.

Her husband, who also suffers from declining health, has left the couple dependent on subsidies as their main source of income. With frequent needs for medical treatment and dialysis, their financial burden has become extremely severe.

Upon learning of the situation, the Kaohsiung Branch arranged, before the Mid-Autumn Festival, for representatives of its Charity Club, case officers, and the local village chief

to visit the family. They offered care and presented a charitable donation. On the spot, they also assisted the husband in applying for a special social welfare account to prevent any future concerns that the subsidy might be subject to compulsory enforcement. The debtor and her husband expressed their heartfelt gratitude, and the village chief was deeply moved by the action.
